The Student Lounge/Kitchen Spaces

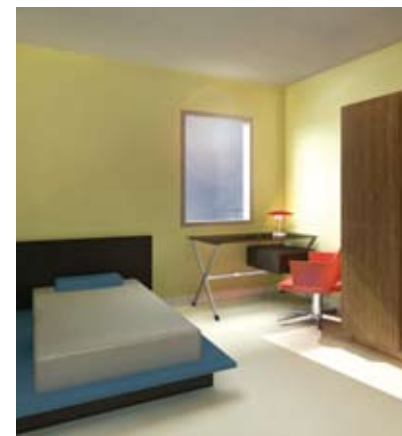
Two 864 sq ft student lounge/kitchen areas located on the third and fifth floors allow students to eat together while discussing homework or cramming for a test.
